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DAY 01 KUALA LUMPUR INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT – KL

Upon your arrival at Kuala Lumpur International Airport (KLIA), our experienced and friendly tour guide will welcome you at the arrival hall. And also our luxurious limousine with the driver will depart for KL city Tour.

The city of Kuala Lumpur was built on the confluence of two rivers, the Klang and the Gombak rivers. The tour will highlight the old and the modern that makes this city vibrant. Places of interest includes visiting a handicraft centre, Jamek Mosque, drive pass Chinatown and Parliament House, photo stop at the King's Palace, Railway station, Sultan Abdul Samad building, National Monument and country's history and culture.

Journey into the outskirts of Kuala Lumpur and discover the amazing sights of nature and traditions. Drive along Ambassadors Row where embassies of various nations are located. Visit the Royal Selangor Pewter factory and pass by Malay villages. See how batik is done by hand. Finally the famous Batu Caves with its 272-steps, these limestone caves are popular tourist attraction for the annual Thaipusam Festival. The festival is a spectacular affair which attracts thousand of devotees and spectators.

Known as the "Garden City Of Lights", Kuala Lumpur comes alive as the sun sets. We will set off in the evening by first visiting the Sri Mahamariamman Temple, the oldest Hindu Temple in the city. A short walk away is Chinatown with its open-air bazaar. Test your bargaining skills! Next proceed to a restaurant and help yourself to a buffet spread of local delicacies. Includes: Cultural Dance with Dinner

DAY 02 PutraJaya – Melaka – D-Paradise

After breakfast, our luxurious limousine with the driver will bring you to Malacca City Tour.

The ruins and building of these conquerors can still be seen today in Malacca Town, blending with the fast developing but careful planned township. Visit St. Peter's Church (1710) - the oldest Christian Church still in use in Malaysia. Drive past the largest 17th century Chinese cemetery outside of China, located at Bukit China or Chinese Hill. Stop at the foothill to view the Sultan's Well before driving through the Portuguese Settlement.

Proceed to view the famous gateway, 'Porta De Santiago' and the ruins of St. Paul's Church lined by 17th century Dutch tombstones. Next on the list is "Red Square" - the salmon pink Dutch administrative buildings which today houses the Malacca Museum and government offices. Visit Christ church before proceeding for the Portuguese Square, where you can try spicy hot devil's curry and other famous Portuguese cuisine. Next we will visit the "Abode Merciful Clouds" or the Cheng Hoon Teng Temple - the only temple where you can find 3 major doctrines of local Chinese belief under the same roof, viz: Taoism, Buddhism and Confucianism. Take a stroll along Malacca's Jonker Street, which ends by the banks of the Malacca River and there start the river cruise to bring you out along the Malacca River. After night tour at River Cruise, proceed to D-Paradise for check in.

D-Paradise which is located at Alor Gajah, Melaka. In the journey from KLIA to D-Paradise, you will find the beautiful scenery along the highway which full with greenish palm oil estate. Before enter D-Paradise, the typical Malaysia 'Kampong' scene definitely will catch you attention. The typical Malay houses, buffalos, village market, plants and others are along the journey.

D-Paradise is famed for its 168 acres of fruits farm & native village. You will spend the whole day in D-Paradise to discover over 800 species of fruits, flowers & vegetables. You will be given a self drive buggy to move around the park in D-Paradise, along the buggy way, there is a 9 km passion fruit shaded canopy to shield you from the sun. In the park, you will find animals like deer, ostriches, quails, the biggest land crab, robber crabs and others. At night, you will be lead by the native to explore the jungle by searching rare animals & secret of jungle.

DAY 03 D-Paradise

Have your breakfast under a jackfruit tree; you will enjoy the best orchard morning sunrise view while having your breakfast. This is the nature experience rarely found in other place except in Melaka Areas..

After breakfast, Enjoy a village tour; here you will see the traditional Malay village lifestyle on your bicycles and stop over a traditional coffee shop for a coffee break. You will see the Malay people living style, and see in detail how they make traditional cake and serve to the guest in a traditional way.

On the way back to the D-Paradise, you luckily see how a group of Buffalo going together even crossing the street without seeing the a dangerous car pass between them. You will can not see this kind of animal just going to feed themselves in a free areas including the road side.

GET READY!!! EXPLORE THE JUNGLE HUNTING..... Learn the survival skills of natives hunting in the jungle.

Lunch will be provided in the jungle with the natives, and learn to see how native doing their daily life and prepare their cooking matter. Sitting on the floor and using the old fashion way of cooking and enjoying the meal with your own feeling.

In the evening, a dinner will be served in your private Kampung House, in the Plunge pool deck, with romantic banana trunk candle decoration. A real romantic dinner served by the well trained butler and will make you a night full of romance.

Day 4 D-Paradise - Phuket

Breakfast in a deer park....you will be fascinated to have your early meal with the sound of deer and goats.

Arrive at the Airport , the professional Airport Representative will await for you and get all Passport as well as document for Immigration purposes.You will be escorted to the private arrival Lounge with a foot and back massage while waiting for the luggage.

Day 05 Phuket

It's 8:30 in the morning on a gloriously sunny day and here comes the mini van to pick us up. We've read up about Phuket's history and a fascinating read it was so we're looking forward to seeing the Old Town and Wat Chalong among other sights.

But first we're taken down the west coast of the island, sweeping through Patong Beach, Karon Beach and Kata Beach.

It's funny how Patong looks radically different by day – you'd never guess that only hours ago thousands of people were partying here.

Patong Beach certainly looks inviting but Karon, seen from the hill as we descend towards it, is positively gorgeous, as is Kata with its palm-lined strand and crashing surf.

In fact when the van stops at the 'sam haad' (three beaches) viewpoint, the first thing we see is a vista of Kata and Karon beaches with Kata Noi Beach almost directly under us.

It's breezy up here but we still need the suntan lotion and hats as, even at 9:15 in the morning, the sun is incredibly strong.

One of the most photographed sights in Phuket is Phromthep Cape, a high ridge of land above a sharp peninsula jutting out into the Andaman Sea. It's deliciously windy up here plus there's a lot to see.

A huge collection of wooden and stone elephants of every shape and colour surrounds a shrine to the god Brahma and to the side is a lighthouse with views out over the south of the island and some islands just off the coast.

From here we can see just how green Phuket is – contrast that with the bright turquoise of the sea and you'll know why so many people love coming here.

After an ice-cold coconut drink (from the nut itself) we're heading north to Wat Chalong. This Buddhist temple is the biggest on the island and the repository of a lot of fascinating history. People say that this is the spiritual heart of Phuket and it's easy to see why, as the temple grounds are quite busy with people lighting joss sticks at shrines and generally taking in the atmosphere. The colour combinations on the temple walls and inside are startling.

Wang Thalung Pearl and Gem Gallery is next, where we learn that at the end of Phuket's tin mining boom, pearl cultivation was introduced and there are many sizes and types to choose from here.

We all settle down to watch a 20-minute movie that explains the history of Phuket, how pearls are cultivated, with a lot of background information.

Apparently, along Phuket's sheltered east coast and nearby islands pearls are cultivated. Later we have a good look at the gems on offer.

It's getting near midday and we stop for a fresh juice before heading back into Phuket Town. For the last stop of our tour we're shown the charms of Phuket's old town. Over the centuries, Phuket has been subject to many foreign influences, resulting in its distinctive architecture. 'Sino-Portuguese' is the term used to describe the houses in the old town.

Well, I never knew you could pack so much into five hours. We've learned a lot, mission accomplished, and it's time to go back to our hotel.

Day 06 Phuket

A light sound of bird will wake you up and to welcome you enjoying the breakfast (provided by Hotel)

Free & easy~ there's a lot to see and do in Phuket and the island is big enough to offer many options when it comes to sightseeing. Phuket also has a vibrant history that is written large in its architecture and culture, resulting in a unique and sometimes mysterious mixture of modern and ancient, foreign and local.
