DAY 01 KUALA LUMPUR INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT – KL

Upon your arrival at Kuala Lumpur International Airport (KLIA), our experienced and friendly tour guide will welcome you at the arrival hall. And also our luxurious limousine with the driver will be waiting for you.

The city of Kuala Lumpur was built on the confluence of two rivers, the Klang and the Gombak rivers. The tour will highlight the old and the modern that makes this city vibrant. Places of interest includes visiting a handicraft centre, Jamek Mosque, drive pass Chinatown and Parliament House, photo stop at the King's Palace, Railway station, Sultan Abdul Samad building, National Monument and country's history and culture.

Journey into the outskirts of Kuala Lumpur and discover the amazing sights of nature and traditions. Drive along Ambassadors Row where embassies of various nations are located. Visit the Royal Selangor Pewter factory and pass by Malay villages. See how batik is done by hand. Finally the famous Batu Caves with its 272-steps, these limestone caves are popular tourist attraction for the annual Thaipusam Festival. The festival is a spectacular affair which attracts thousand of devotees and spectators.

Known as the "Garden City Of Lights", Kuala Lumpur comes alive as the sun sets. We will set off in the evening by first visiting the Sri Mahamariamman Temple, the oldest Hindu Temple in the city. A short walk away is Chinatown with its open-air bazaar. Test your bargaining skills! Next proceed to a restaurant and help yourself to a buffet spread of local delicacies.

DAY 02 PutraJaya – Melaka – D-Paradise

After breakfast, our luxurious limousine with the driver will bring you to Putrajaya "Intelligent Garden City" – Malaysia. Depart for Putrajaya at 0900 hours.

Putrajaya, covering an area of 4,931 hectares of land, is situated 25 kilometers from the capital city of Kuala Lumpur in the north and 20 kilometers from Kuala Lumpur International Airport (KLIA) at Sepang in the south.

Putrajaya is the new Administrative Centre of the Federal Government of Malaysia. Situated within the Multimedia Super Corridor (MSC), the development of Putrajaya marks a new chapter in the history of modern city planning in Malaysia. It is set to be a model garden city with sophisticated information network base on multimedia technologies.

Termed as Malaysia's first Intelligent Garden City, Putrajaya will become a vital development catalyst due to the role it will assume as a model city - as the nerve centre of the nation and an ideal place to live, work, conduct business and engage in sports and recreational activities.

About 40% of Putrajaya is natural. Lush greenery, botanical gardens are spread across the landscape enhanced by large bodies of water and wetlands. Five confluences meet at the north forming a main waterway which flows across the city area.

Architecturally, Putrajaya will be an indigenous city with a modern look. Planned to the most minute detail, this intelligent garden city will enhance the goal of the nation in nurturing a caring and progressive society.

Putrajaya promises a comfortable and quality lifestyle for its residents. Lush greenery, botanical gardens and parks are spread across landscapes enhanced by large bodies of water and wetlands. Residential areas are supported by commercial hubs and public amenities that are planned and integrated for an ideal "live-work" environment.

Putrajaya will use multimedia technologies to become an electronic administrative centre. Interdepartmental communications and interactions with the public will be conducted via electronic and multimedia channels. The development of Putrajaya and its twin city, Cyberjaya, will position the MSC competitively in the international arena. After lunch proceed to Malacca City Tour.

The ruins and building of these conquerors can still be seen today in Malacca Town, blending with the fast developing but carefully planned township. Visit St. Peter's Church (1710) - the oldest Christian Church still in use in Malaysia. Drive past the largest 17th century Chinese cemetery outside of China, located at Bukit China or Chinese Hill. Stop at the foothill to view the Sultan's Well before driving through the Portuguese Settlement.

Proceed to view the famous gateway, 'Porta De Santiago' and the ruins of St. Paul's Church lined by 17th century Dutch tombstones.

Next on the list is “Red Square” - the salmon pink Dutch administrative buildings which today houses the Malacca Museum and government offices. Visit Christ church before proceeding for the Potugese Square, where you can try spicy hot devil’s curry and other famous protugese cuisine. Next we will visit the “Abode Merciful Clouds’ or the Cheng Hoon Teng Temple - the only temple where you can find 3 major doctrines of local Chinese belief under the same roof, viz: Taoism, Buddhism and Confucianism. Take a stroll along Malacca’s Jonker Street, which ends by the banks of the Malacca River and there start the river cruise to bring you out along the Malacca River.

After night tour at River Cruise, proceed to D-Paradise for check in.

D-Paradise which is located at Alor Gajah, Melaka. In the journey from KLIA to D-Paradise, you will find the beautiful scenery along the highway which full with greenish palm oil estate. Before enter D-Paradise, the typical Malaysia ‘Kampong’ scene definitely will catch you attention. The typical Malay houses, buffalos, village market, plants and others are along the journey.

D-Paradise is famed for its 168 acres of fruits farm & native village. You will spend the whole day in D-Paradise to discover over 800 species of fruits, flowers & vegetables. You will be given a self drive buggy to move around the park in D-Paradise, along the buggy way, there is a 9 km passion fruit shaded canopy to shield you from the sun. In the park, you will find animals like deer, ostriches, quails, the biggest land crab, robber crabs and others. At night, you will be lead by the native to explore the jungle by searching rare animals & secret of jungle.

DAY 03 D-Paradise

Have your breakfast under a jackfruit tree; you will enjoy the best orchard morning sunrise view while having your breakfast. This is the nature experience rarely found in other place except in Melaka Areas..

Enjoy your breakfast on a hilltop of the entire durian trees and surrounded by the cempedak tree as well as a nice view for miracle fruit.

GET READY!!! EXPLORE THE JUNGLE HUNTING..... learn the survival skills of natives hunting in the jungle.

Lunch will be provided in the jungle with the natives, and learn to see how native doing their daily life and prepare their cooking matter. Sitting on the floor and using the old fashion way of cooking and enjoying the meal with your own feeling.

In the evening, a dinner will be served in your private Kampung House, in the Plunge pool deck, with romantic banana trunk candle decoration. A real romantic dinner served by the well trained butler and will make you a night full of romance.

DAY 04 D-PARADISE – Bali

Proceed to Bedugul , a tropical rain forest and botanical garden, a large areas conservation for the water resource in the slop of Mount Batukaru. You will enjoy a variety of tropical trees, cactus, flowers and a green house to cultivate any kind of trees in Bali.

Before leaving for Tanah Lot temple, enjoy the nice view of Water temple and boating in the Buyan lake, while enjoy the Lunch in the lake side of Buyan.

Through a small but nice road go down to the mountain slope to Tabanan Regency where you will find a nice rice field , a famous rice field called “ Jatuh Luwih” the rice old stock for the whole Balinese areas. Then preceding to the Mongkey Forest, Alas Kedaton” to see a group monkeys living harmonically with the people around and becoming on of the tourist attraction .

Another forty five minutes journey, you will arrive in “Tanah Lot “ temple, a temple inside the sea. The temple till now days becoming the best “sun set view” in Bali. You may find a holly snake in side the rock and very unique color ,black and white in the body. According to the priest, who take care this creatures, will give a safe journey to the next destination.

Enjoy the , Balinese coffee in one of the restaurant while facing the fascinating temple “Tanah Lot”

Go back to the Villas in about 30 minutes, and you may lie back and enjoy an hour body massage by one of the Most Popular massage signature “ Martha Tilaar” Spa before enjoying the evening in the villas.
